1	Download & install the Canon Camera Connect App from the App store or Google Play	Control Arrow Coogle: play App Store
2	Press the Menu button on your camera OR Press the Wi-Fi Connect button on selected models (skip to step 7)	
3	Navigate to the 🐓 tab in the camera menu and select "Wireless communication settings" followed by the "Set" button	Select folder File numbering Auto rotate Format card Wireless communication settings
4	Select Wi-Fi / NFC and press the "Set" button	Wireless communication settings Wi-Fi/NFC Disable Wi-Fi function Send images to smartphone Nickname E0S80D Clear settings
